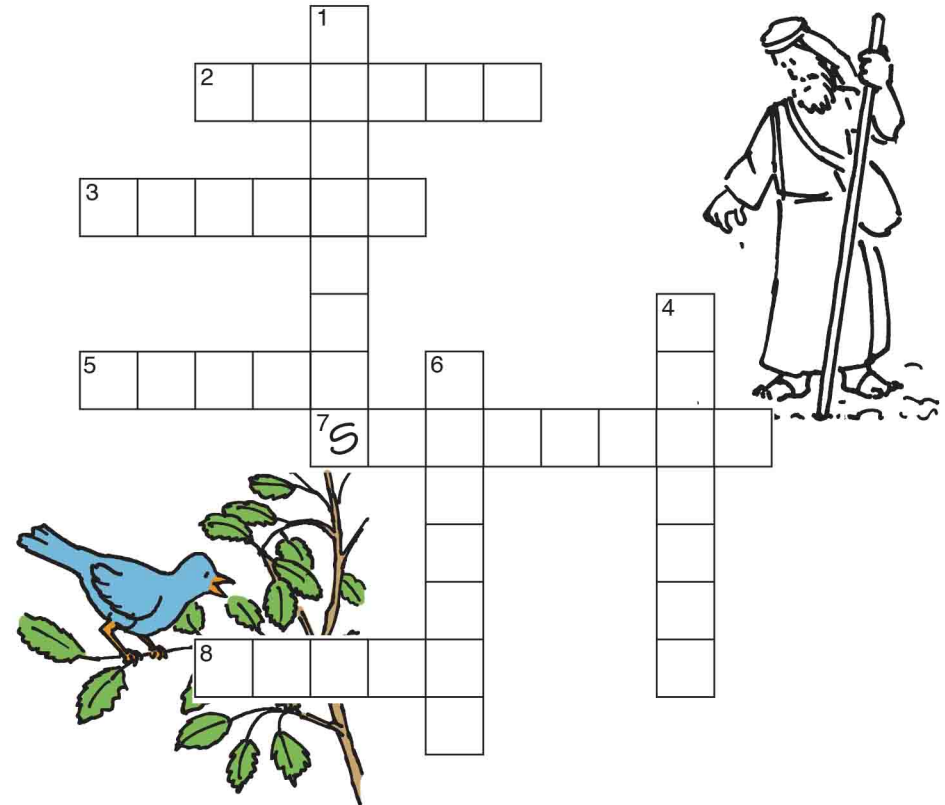


In the second parable, Jesus compared the kingdom of God to a mustard seed.
